Elected Members

Cllr J. McCamon. reported that CCTV in Newton Stewart was progressing with policies and procedures being implemented and some spare parts being required.

R. Kay reported that a meeting had been held with Dumfries and Galloway Council re CCES. He added that it had been agreed that calls would not be closed until the call was complete.

1. Planning

J. Brown reported that following the latest Licensing Board meeting the following issues were outstanding re The Vault application:

- CVCC were not given full information prior to the meeting.
- Cllr. Hagmann was present, however, was in favour

- The application was altered and CVCC were not told in advance of meeting.
- Clerk of the Board made a statement; however, CVCC were not mentioned.
- He felt CVCC were misrepresented.
- No opportunity was given to CVCC for a final submission.

He added that CVCC had not received a reply from Steve Rodgers re planning application for outside use at The Vault.

2. Newton Stewart Flood Protection Scheme

B. Palmer stated that CVCC was still disagreeing with Dumfries and Galloway Council on the requirement for river management on the River Cree.

C. Smithers added that water was leaking through the wall on Riverside Road at the back of the Cinema in Newton Stewart.

B. Palmer added that the DGC Case Officer dismissed the cumulative effect of wind farms in the DGC Meeting discussing the Kilgallioch Wind Farm Extension. He added that the route to be used was not discussed either.
